



# Advantages and Disadvantages of cooperating with NPOs and NGOs

# Advantages and Disadvantages of Collaboration (n=30)



### **Advantages**

- Possibility to actively shape something
- High commitment of practice partners
- Purposeful Surroundings
- New career perspectives
- Close relationship also beyond the project



### **Disadvantages**

- Implementation competencies must be obtained externally
- IT infrastructure incompatible
- Low availability of contact persons
- Low budgets for implementation
- Smaller solution space in order to ensure compatibility

# Learnings



## You are Fighting for Attention -

NPOs have few resources. The work in the projects is in the foreground and the student projects can easily be crowded out.



## Infrastructure Can be a Challenge -

In the context of cooperation with NPOs, problems occur because licenses are not available, and files cannot be made accessible.



## Sometimes it's About the Little Things -

For students, it is sometimes irritating how "small" the projects are. Preparation helps to manage this disconnect.

«The students really contribute here, because NPOs have little resources of their own. This has been very motivating. My career prospects have been strengthened once again and it is now even clearer to me that I want to do something meaningful. »


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
